Zippers (assembled) consisting of:

- polyester tape and nylon coil, white and dyed
- plastic (POM) teeth, coloured with pigments
- brass teeth and zinc alloy slider, electroplated in anti-brass, nickel, gunmetal, anti-silver, dark pewter and yellow brass
- zinc alloy slider, painted
- with or without reinforcement tape made of polypropylene/nylon in milky white

Metal accessories (badges, buttons, buckles, labels, rivet and eyelets) made of brass and zinc alloy, electroplated in anti-brass, nickel, gunmetal, anti-silver, dark pewter and yellow brass

The results of the inspection made according to Oeko-Tex® Standard 100, product class I for baby articles, have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the standard presently established.

The certified articles fulfil the requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo-dyes, nickel, etc.) as well as the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to EN ISO 17050-1, is obliged to use the Oeko-Tex® mark only in conjunction with products that are conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
